such as those of banking, securities, or insurance corporations, and to work as specialists in the financial departments of corporations

- Global Tax Law : This track is intended for those who wish to serve as tax experts in public corporations, securities/ financial corporations, and other organizations
- Global IT & IP Law : This track is intended for those who wish to serve as lawyers who specialize in e-commerce and intellectual property rights, working for corporations such as e-Bay, Auction, and G-market
