

Department of Nursing

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The Department of Nursing aims to produce capable nurses who will have leadership skills and can contribute to the construction of a welfare society as well as the academic development of Oriental and western nursing. The following are the specific objectives:

- Students must be prepared with the basic knowledge, skills and leadership necessary for professional nursing
- Students must try to solve controversial problems in professional nursing using their creativity
- Students must develop the approach using Oriental and western nursing for public health
- Students must be able to understand the basic knowledge and the know-how to apply it
- Students must be able to teach the knowledge and skills that they have acquired
- Students must obtain the basics to manage their situation as a professional nurse

Degree Requirements

- At least 24 course units of graduate level nursing courses are required for the master's degree but at least 33 course units for the nurse practitioner course and 36 course units for the doctorate degree.
- Students must pass a qualifying examination.
- Students must fulfill presentation, defense, and document requirements for the Nursing thesis committee.
- A thesis advisor can be any faculty member from the Nursing Department.
