The master's degree program was established in 1982 and the doctoral degree program in 1992. Our curriculum encompasses, but is not limited to, most major traditions in philosophy such as Continental Western Philosophy, Analytic Philosophy, Chinese Philosophy, and Korean Traditional Philosophy. In each tradition, core issues of philosophy are researched and taught in the department(e.g. epistemology, metaphysics, ethics, social philosophy, philosophy of science, philosophy of culture, etc.). These studies should deepen and develop the students' knowledge of philosophy. Our mission in the graduate course is to develop the students' ability to become a professional teacher in all academic platforms which require philosophical talents.

| Degree Requirements |

- At least 24 course units of graduate level credit in philosophy are required for the master's degree and 36 course units for the doctoral degree.
- Students must pass a qualifying examination(3 subjects for the master/doctoral degree).
- Students must pass a doctoral(or master's) thesis for a degree.
